CONSERVATION CONGRESS COUNTY MEETING RESOLUTION

Monday, April 16, 2007

TITLE: Rifle hunting for ALL of Dunn County during deer-gun seasons

THE PROBLEM:

Currently all of Dunn County lands north of highway 170 are open to rifle hunting during deer-gun season. All Dunn County lands south of highway 170 are closed to rifle hunting and are open to shotgun hunting only during deer-gun season.

The problem could be simplified for non-county Wisconsin resident hunters who are owners of rifles and who wish to use one type of gun rather than change from rifle to shotgun depending whether they hunt north or south of highway 170.

It has never been established that personal safety is in either more or less jeopardy north of highway 170 versus south of highway 170 due to a change from rifle hunting to shotgun hunting only.

Eau Claire County, which is contiguous to Dunn County, has rifle hunting for the entire season throughout the county.

Unnecessary enforcement problems by the DNR Wardens would be simplified or eliminated by making the entire Dunn County open to rifle hunting.

There are nine days per year that a rifle cannot be used south of highway 170 in Dunn County and that is during the deer-gun season.

RESOLUTION: # 1

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that rifle hunting be allowed during deer-gun season for ALL of Dunn County.
