SCOPES ON MUZZLELOADERS

SITUATION: When muzzleloading was introduced, exposed hammers were required. Within two years, criteria was revised to accept inline and moisture-proof actions similar to modern weapons. At this time, 1x scopes are legal to use during the muzzleloading season. Crossbows are considered a primitive weapon, as well, and multi-powered scopes are allowed as a sighting device during archery seasons.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Shawano County on April 16, 2007 supports multi-powered scopes that can be used on muzzleloaders as a sight device during the traditional muzzleloader season or any gun season. This will replace the 1x restriction on muzzleloaders.
