The Problem:

Under the current rules hunters are allowed to harvest one buck for every antlerless deer they shoot.

I propose a system in which hunters are only allowed to harvest one buck for each license they purchase, archery and gun. This would allow more bucks to survive each year, especially the younger bucks which would then have a chance to mature. It would also discourage hunters from over harvesting in areas that are already seeing a dramatic decrease in the overall deer population.

Additionally, this would be a step in ending the earn-a-buck systems that so many hunters oppose.
