Modify existing youth hunting rules to include any novice with less than three years of hunting experience

Presently the fastest growing segment of the hunting population is women, to encourage this; existing rules should be modified to include any resident novice hunter regardless of age with less than three years of hunting experience. (Experience can be documented by previous hunting license sales) This rule proposal is designed to help inexperienced hunters have a safe and rewarding first-time hunting experience under the immediate guidance of an experienced hunter

At present, state law does not differentiate between youth and novice in letting inexperienced hunters participate in existing youth hunts.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation congress at its annual meeting recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this situation by modifying existing youth hunt formats to include novices.
