Title: Archery Group Hunting Under Earn-a-Buck Conditions.

The Problem: Currently there is no group hunting with archery allowed. Under normal archery seasons an archer is allowed to take either sex. Under Earn-a-Buck rules a hunter is required to harvest an antler less deer first.

There is currently group hunting with firearms already in place.

Harvesting an antler less deer with archery can be much more challenging.

If group hunting were allowed, a youth, or hunting partner under standard group hunting rules could harvest an antler less deer, or if the partner has a valid Earn-a-Buck sticker the youth or hunting partner could harvest a buck.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Sauk County on April 13, 2009 recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to introduce this rule change allowing Group Hunting for Archery in Earn-a-Buck units.
