BE IT RESOLVED, The Sheboygan County Conservation Association, at the Annual Conservation Congress meeting in April, 2009, held in Sheboygan County, recommends that all first time Hunter Education graduates through 16 years of age who apply for a spring turkey permit be given first preference in receiving one. This is to be a one time privilege only good for the first year after graduation. By getting started in turkey hunting we hope it inspires them to continue.
