Title: 2nd Archery Buck Tag

The Problem:

Current law in Wisconsin allows a hunter to shoot a buck deer with an archery license and second buck deer with a gun or muzzleloader for a total of two bucks per season. The problem is if a hunter does not shoot a buck during the gun or muzzleloader season after the gun deer season is concluded that tag is done.

Around the holidays it would be nice to be able to go back out archery hunting and fill that unused buck tag. A hunter would still be allowed only a total of two bucks. By making this change the hunter would just have another option to fill their two tags for the year. The option would ONLY be valid after the gun and muzzleloader season is concluded.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Dunn County on April 12, 2010 recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this situation by introducing rule change to allow an archer to shoot two bucks in one season.
