YOUTH PERMIT AND LICENCE TRANSFER

The Problem: At the present time we are continually trying to recruit youth into the sport of hunting and the outdoors. The ability to transfer permits and licenses is difficult and some times impossible to do. A couple a years ago it was made possible to transfer many permits and or licenses to a youth, because one of the guidelines to be able to do such a transaction is that it has to be done 15 days before start of the season which the permit of license is good for, it is impossible to do this when the permits are not in the possession of the applicant until 7-10 days before the season begins. This is really a problem when trying to transfer bobcat, fisher, and otter permits. Also the ability to transfer a turkey permit bought over the counter can not be transferred to a youth presently.

Where as there is no reason that a harvest permit or license could not nor should not have the ability to be transferred to a youth at any time even if it is the day before the season or during the season, especially given the fact of the technology we have today with computers and the alas system. This would give youth more of an opportunity to enjoy and participate in the outdoors.

Where as we need to continue to give our youth the opportunity and the ability to be able to participate in some of the outdoor activities we have enjoyed for many seasons.

There fore be it resolved that here in Price County on April 12th 2010 we approve the ability to transfer harvest permits and licenses to youth up to and during all harvest seasons including over the counter turkey harvest permits.
