Title: Making land owner preference tag property specific

The Problem:

Land owners who obtain tags through the landowner preference system can currently use those tags anywhere in the zone for which it is issued, this would include public hunting grounds. With the new larger zone and competition for prime tags increasing, plus limited public hunting in some areas this advantage needs to be addressed.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting in Walworth County on April 11, 2011 recommend's that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this situation by introducing rule changes making licenses obtained through land owner preference tags not valid on public land. Property specific tags, valid only on the owner's property and/or adjacent land would be an option. At the very least valid only on private land.
