Eliminate Hunting Stamp Requirements For Youth

Currently, 10-17 year olds must purchase a Small Game License and Pheasant Stamp if they're going to hunt Pheasants. 10-17 years olds must purchase a Turkey License and Turkey Stamp if they're going to hunt turkey.

The Junior Small Game License is for youth 12-17 years old. 12-15 year olds aren't required to purchase a Federal or State Duck Stamp in order to hunt waterfowl, but 16 & 17 year olds are required to purchase both stamps if they're going to hunt waterfowl.

Wisconsin should eliminate all state hunting stamp requirements for youth 10-17 years of age

In an effort to: recruit youth hunters; increase youth hunting opportunity; simplify hunting rules by eliminating Pheasant, Turkey and State Waterfowl Stamps for youth

BE IT RESOLVED, the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Racine County on April 9, 2012, recommends that the Department of Natural Resources work with the State Legislature to introduce legislation that would eliminate all hunting stamp requirements for youth 10-17 years of age.
