The Problem
Whitetail Deer Education

Deer in Wisconsin hold a special place in most of our citizens. Even tonight, most of us here are concerned about deer. There is a need for a short, 3 to 4 hour class on explaining what a deer's life from birth to death. The class would cover food needs, habitat, predators, starvation, and other things that are involved with Wisconsin deer. The class could be taught by specially trained Hunter Education Instructors or other volunteers. A rebate from deer licenses could be an incentive to attend the class. There is a need to recover the respect we had for deer that we have lost with extra tags, free tags, CWD, and other issues. Bring back the reputation of deer as one of our greatest resources.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held on April 14, in Bayfield County recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department create this class and help implement it.
