RESOLUTION

The Problem:

When fingerling fish are planted in an effort to establish a sport fishing opportunity, it is difficult to succeed without some type of protection.

The Lake Beulah Protection and Improvement Association with the Triangle Sportsman's Club Inc. with the approval of the DNR will plant approximately 2000 fingerling small mouth bass in Lake Beulah for each of three consecutive years.

There is a slot limit for bass in Lake Beulah, but no minimum size limit.

Be it resolved that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Walworth County on April 14, 2014, recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the DNR to take action to establish a closed season for small mouth bass on Lake Beulah for three years when the small mouth bass are planted.
