Expand the metro unit in Manitowoc Co. to a point north of Point Beach state forest and east of I-43

Manitowoc Co. has a growing deer population in an area where there is limited access and land parcels are rather fragmented. Metro units allow for additional harvest opportunity for those who may have access in areas of limited access.

Whereas the current Metro Unit in Manitowoc Co. only encompasses about 9 square miles in the southeast corner of the County.

Whereas many hunters think the area of the county north of the current Metro Unit has a larger deer population than many other parts of the county.

Whereas an expanded Metro Unit would cover (Manitowoc and Two Rivers) the two largest cities in the county.

Therefore be it resolved, the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Manitowoc Co. on April 13th 2015, request the DNR expand the current Metro Unit in Manitowoc Co to extend north of Point Beach State Forest and encompass all area east of I-43.
