Canada goose punch system

The law as written states "When a Canada goose is killed and before it is carried by hand or transported in any manner, the hunter who killed the goose must validate their Canada goose hunting permit.

In Illinois the punch system was used from 2001-2002 to 2003-2004 & the department collected adequate samples of hunter compliance checks to provide reliable harvest control information. The 3 year evaluation was discontinued at the end of the 2003-2004 season. I would think Wisconsin would have figured it out after a decade of using the punch system.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting in Racine County on April 13th, 2015 work with the department to change this rule by eliminating the punch validation system & only using data collected from Conservation officers. Having to do both is redundant and an unnecessary burden on the hunter.
