The Problem Cable Restraints

The problems with cable restraints are that they are so cheap that anyone can set a large number of them and forget them. It is too easy for someone to not check them frequently. Lack of a legal ID tag is another part of the problem. Finally, hunting dogs are being trapped. A stop, properly set and functioning, on a cable restraint will not ensure that a dog is not injured or killed if it would be caught. These restraints are cruel and inhumane.

At Present, state law allows their use.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress, at its annual meeting held in Waukesha Country on April 13, 2015, recommend that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this situation by eliminating the use of cable restraint/snares from Wisconsin by making their use illegal.
