
Whereas, Agropur Corporation discharges pollutants to unnamed tributaries of the East Twin River in Kewaunee County via its WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT.

THIS WPDES PERMIT ISSUED ON JANUARY 29TH OF 2016 BY THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (WDNR) PERMITS THE INCREASE IN POLLUTANTS BEING DISCHARGED INTO THE EPA DESIGNATED IMPAIRED WATERS OF THE EAST TWIN RIVER TO A TOTAL OF 3281 POUNDS PER DAY FROM THE PRIOR AMOUNT OF 1300 POUNDS PER DAY.

This increase in pollutant discharge will result in a marked increase in the degradation of the waters of the East Twin River and may permanently destroy waters that belong to the Public Trust for now and future generations of Wisconsin and the United States of America.

BE IT RESOLVED, that this Conservation Congress held at its annual meeting in Kewaunee County on April 11th, 2016, recommends that this Conservation Congress call upon the WDNR to immediately rescind this WPDES permit as a significant beginning action to start the responsible act of meeting duties of the WDNR in fulfilling its enforcement responsibilities under the CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA) OF THE U.S. OF AMERICA and as outlined in the 75 provisions of the CWA.
