Instructions for Application Addendum for Private Lead Service Line Replacement Projects:

1) **Type of private Lead Service Line Project:**

Please check the applicable box(es) and use the spaces provided to describe in as much detail as possible the type of project for which you are requesting funding.

It is understood that information provided on the number of existing LSLs or the number of LSLs to be replaced in the current project is only an estimate. If applying for funding for a municipal program, estimate the number of replacements that can be made with the funding provided.

- 2) If you **are requesting SDWLP funding** for a watermain replacement project in addition to the private LSL funding, your application will not be considered complete unless you submit this Addendum as well as all applicable sections of Form 8700-262 (Rev 04/16) by June 30th to the address on the front of this form.
- 3) If you **are not requesting any additional SDWLP funding** other than the private LSL PF funding, not all sections of Form 8700-262 (R 04/16) are required to be submitted for your application to be considered complete. Form 8700-262 and this Addendum must still be submitted by June 30th to the address on the front of this form.

A complete application for projects **only** requesting private LSL PF funds **must include** pages 1 through 4 of Form 8700-262 (Rev 04/16).

- Page one contains a checklist of items that need to be submitted with the application. Only items number 1 and 13 will apply to most LSL PF-only applications. If engineering costs are being requested, items 9, 11, & 12 are required, as applicable, (the construction management contract may be submitted later if not yet available). Environmental review requirements **do** apply but information is not required to be submitted with the application for spot replacement projects or a municipal program. Details of how to conduct the environmental review will be worked out after application submittal.
- Page two contains a list of additional documentation that is required prior to preparation of the Financial Assistance Agreement. Some of these items may apply. Your assigned project manager will work with you to determine the items that are applicable to your municipality's situation.
- Page three contains contact information. Note that Bond Counsel is not needed for a PF-only application. A Consulting Engineer or Financial Advisor are also not required but may be utilized if desired.
