I have final project worksheets from FEMA, as attached.

For ATV, our original application was for \$130,316.70 in damages @ 12.5% grant match = \$16,289.59.
Final FEMA damages are \$129,545.54 @ 12.5% grant match - \$16,193.19

For Snow, our original application was for \$53,428.40 @ 12.5% grant match = \$6,678.55
Our FEMA damages included work on trail 7B, which is not funded by Snowmobile Trail Aids. Total FEMA award is \$60,951.68, less \$7,455.14 applied to trail 7B nets a Snow Council value of \$53,496.54.
12.5% grant match under snowmobile = \$6,687.07


A severe rainstorm hit the northern half of Washburn County on July 11, 2016. Areas within this event received in excess of 12 inches of rain. Damages on the certain Snowmobile trails occurred primarily on hills where the run off exceeded the capacity of our stormwater discharge and erosion control mechanisms. Severe washouts and loss of material occurred in numerous locations. This application is a request for matching funds for the FEMA declaration that has been made for this area. The figures included here are 12.5% of the total estimate submitted to FEMA

WHEREAS, financial aid is often required to carry out the projects;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Washburn County attempts to budget sums sufficient to complete the projects in the Outdoor Recreation Plan, and







 Sec. 6 T40N-R13W


