**The following materials are grant eligible: 1995 items banned from landfills, including yard waste, collected from single family and 2-4 unit residential housing.**

**The following materials are non-grant eligible: 1991 items banned from landfills and collected from single family and 2-4 unit residential housing.**

Air conditioners	Lead-acid vehicle batteries	Computers – desktop, laptop, netbook, tablet
Boilers	Oil absorbents	Computer keyboards and mice
Clothes Washers	Used oil filters	Computer scanners
Clothes dryers	Waste oils (waste oil may be burned in a solid waste treatment facility with energy recovery)	Computer speakers
Refrigerators	Used tires from home business or farm business	External hard drives
