SUMMARY:

The 2008 Leadership Dynamics class at Badger High School, Lake Geneva, Wisconsin raised \$10,310.00 through various fundraisers and has donated a new park entrance sign, a large group size grill for the picnic shelter, 15 family size grills for the front picnic area, 25 fire rings for the campground, 2 landscaped gardens for the park entrance and labor to stain all existing park picnic tables at Big Foot Beach State Park in Lake Geneva.

The new sign will replace the existing sign. The gardens will create a positive first impression of the park. The picnic grills and fire rings will replace several throughout the park and the large grill for the shelter will ensure that families and groups using the shelter have adequate cooking facilities.

These donations will be used in a manner that ensures park visitors will have a high quality park experience for years to come when visiting Big Foot Beach State Park.
