Walleyes for Tomorrow has donated a new 18 foot KANN boat, trailer and 40 horsepower mercury outboard motor to the Barron Fisheries office.

Fisheries staff has many waters to sample and this new boat will increase their effectiveness and efficiency and replaces a smaller boat which will ultimately make their jobs safer.


