

SUBJECT: LAND ACQUISITION – KETTLE MORAINE STATE FOREST/SOUTHERN UNIT– WALWORTH COUNTY
FOR: OCTOBER 2008 BOARD MEETING

SUMMARY: The Department has obtained an option to purchase 70 acres of land from Connelly-Daveler for \$435,000 for the Kettle Moraine State Forest Southern Unit in Walworth County. The item is being submitted because the purchase price is greater than \$150,000.

The 70-acre Connelly-Daveler property is proposed for purchase for forest management and natural resource protection, as well as for public recreation in the Kettle Moraine State Forest Southern Unit. The property abuts state-owned lands on the north, south and part of the east side. It is located in Walworth County in the Town of Whitewater about three miles east of the City of Whitewater. The parcel includes rare and threatened plants on the wooded hill. It is adjacent to the La Grange woods, which is the largest contiguous block of forestland in the Southern Unit and important for forest interior bird species such as the cerulean and hooded warblers. Acquisition of the parcel is important to protect valuable upland woods and glacial features from incompatible development and habitat fragmentation; to expand a significantly sized block of woods; and to provide opportunities for hunters, bird watchers, and passive outdoor recreation enthusiasts. The Department plans to restore about 20 acres to a wetland and to increase forest cover on the balance of the parcel.

The Kettle Moraine State Forest Southern Unit was established in 1936 to provide recreational opportunities in the southeastern portion of the state and to protect the natural and scenic values of the Kettle Moraine landscape. The property is used by the public for hunting, fishing, trapping, cross-country skiing, camping, hiking, and other outdoor recreation. In addition, the geologic and natural values of the area are used for research and education. The project, an all season property, is located in southeastern Wisconsin in Waukesha, Jefferson, and Walworth Counties. The forest is located about 35 miles west of Milwaukee, within 100 miles of five million people.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approve the purchase of 70 acres of land for \$435,000 for Kettle Moraine State Forest/Southern Unit in Walworth County.





Location: The property is located in Walworth County about three miles east of the City of Whitewater in the Town of Whitewater.

Land Description: The subject land varies significantly in topography with the highest areas of elevation being at the southwest portion of the property and the lowest areas being agricultural lands on the north-central portion.

2. JUSTIFICATION:

The 70-acre Connelly-Daveler property is proposed for purchase for forest management and natural resource protection, as well as for public recreation in the Kettle Moraine State Forest Southern Unit. The Department plans to restore wetland on about 20 acres of the lowest soil and to increase forest cover on the balance of the parcel.

The Kettle Moraine State Forest Southern Unit was established in 1936 to provide recreational opportunities in the southeastern portion of the state and to protect the natural and scenic values of the Kettle Moraine landscape. The property is used by the public for hunting, fishing, trapping, cross-country skiing, camping, hiking, and other outdoor recreation. In addition, the geologic and natural values of the area are used for research and education. The project, an all season property, is located in southeastern Wisconsin in Waukesha, Jefferson, and Walworth Counties. The forest is located about 35 miles west of Milwaukee, within 100 miles of five million people.

The entire parcel is part of the interlobate moraine that is the basis for the creation of the Kettle Moraine State Forest. The interlobate moraine consists of a roughly 75-mile long north-south ridgeline that is formed from glacial deposits creating a variety of glacial features. To the west of this moraine in the Town of Eagle, which this parcel is located in, is the Scuppermong River Habitat Preservation Area. This Scuppermong River area is located in what had been a large glacial lake. Numerous springs exist in the moraine ridge that flow to the west and create the Scuppermong River, ultimately flowing to the Rock and Mississippi Rivers.

The Department recommends the purchase of the Connelly-Daveler parcel to provide for public recreation, to prevent incompatible use, to consolidate state ownership and to achieve the goals of the Kettle Moraine State Forest/Southern Unit.






