SUBJECT: Renaming of the Seymour - New London State Trail and renaming of the Denmark-Rockwood State Trail

SUMMARY:

As part of our operating agreement with our cooperative trail partners, the DNR encourages the counties to choose appropriate names for the trails which they develop and manage. As chosen by the Outagamie County Trails Committee, "Newton Blackmour State Trail" represents first the name of several communities through which the trail passes: NEW London, ShioctON, BLACK Creek, and SeyMOUR.

As chosen by the leadership of Brown and Manitowoc Counties, "Devil's River State Trail" represents the Devil's River valley through which the trail meanders for several miles.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board approve the name "Newton Blackmour State Trail" for the Seymour-New London trail and the name "Devil's River State Trail" for the Denmark-Rockwood trail.
