**SUMMARY:**

The Friends of Hartman Creek State Park would like to donate \$19,386 towards the purchase of a Bobcat Tractor. The tractor is a 2009 Bobcat Tractor, model number CT450.

Hartman Creek State Park has over 20 miles of trails, a public beach, 101 campsites, 3 picnic areas, and many miles of roadway. This new tractor will replace the park's current tractor which is in constant disrepair, is often not safe to use, and does not fulfill the needs of the park. This new tractor will help the park perform maintenance and other daily park activities such as mow trails and roadsides, groom the park's beach, campsite renovation work, and general maintenance of the park's grounds.

This donation will be used in a manner that ensures park visitors will have a high quality park experience for years to come.






