Informational Item: Potential emission reductions posed by EPA's Reasonable Progress requirements, new particulate matter standards and proposed new ozone standards.

SUMMARY:

At the August 2007 meeting, the Board tabled adoption of rules under AM-04-06 related to Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) for visibility protection. The Board requested that the Department provide additional information on efforts to control visibility through reasonable progress requirements, measures necessary to meet the 8-hour ozone standard and requirements necessary to meet the fine-particle standards. Mike Koerber from the Lake Michigan Air Directors Consortium (LADCO) will present results from recent analyses conducted by LADCO that address the Board's request for additional information. LADCO is a multi-state organization created by the states of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio and Wisconsin to assist the states in the development of plans to address interstate air quality problems including ozone, haze and visibility. This informational item will provide the Board with the additional background that was requested prior to the consideration of adoption of the BART rules.


