SUMMARY:

Ducks Unlimited has worked with Dow AgroSciences to provide a donation of fifty (50) bags of sunflower seed to Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Bureau of Wildlife Management. The fair market value of the seed ranges from \$160 to \$200 per bag for a total value of \$8,000 to \$10,000. This generous donation will provide increased hunting opportunities for bird hunters in Wisconsin.
