The Friends of Lapham Peak will donate \$12,384.95 to the Department to assist in funding snowmaking operations and cross-country ski trail maintenance at the Kettle Moraine State Forest - Lapham Peak Unit located in the Milwaukee metro area. Snow making capabilities at Lapham Peak provide cross country skiing opportunities often times before snow is provided by natural weather conditions extending the cross-country skiing season. 
