TITLE;

Disabled class "a" and "c" ground blind or elevated device exception.

PROBLEM;

Class "a' and "c" disabled hunters find it very difficult or impossible to erect and then disable a ground blind or a tree stand on a daily basis

SOLUTION;

Allow class "a' and "c" disabled hunters statewide to leave their blinds or stands up for the duration of the hunting season.

CONCLUSION;

I understand that a disabled hunter is allowed a helper and this is a help. However they have their own busy schedules and obligations and often can not accommodate a disabled hunter. This exception would allow a disabled hunter to be more independent.
