Question 9: Please list any additional range rules that you feel should be considered for the Columbia County Shooting Range.

1. The current layout looks good.
2. There should be no exploding targets allowed. Also a phone number should be listed to report violations of the rules as they are being seen. This phone number should be answered by a live person who can send help if needed.
3. We strongly would like to see no explosive targets, either homemade or purchased. We would like to have a phone number listed that can be called if the rules are being broken. We would also like to make certain this is a manned phone number where response would be immediate to the call.
4. Range attendant present at all times.
5. Attendant present at all times.
6. **KEEP THE 25 FOOT PISTOL RANGE AT ALL COSTS.**
Would like to shoot at rubber targets mounted on or affixed directly on the 25 foot berm.
7. If a person gets caught violating safety rules the fine needs to be very high.
8. Signage should encourage use of non-toxic shot and reasons behind it.
If the area turns into a dump site the range should be cut down.
9. no shooting at night by using car lights., definitely no tannerite brand target are to be used or any other types of explosive targets ,tv, glass ,tin cans, etc. paper targets only.
10. No firearms out of the case, except at the shooting station.* Sweeping people with muzzles, even if a gun is empty, presents a potential safety issue. The "empty firearm" is the firearm that causes injury.
In our current range we have tried to make everything idiot proof, but live in fear of the "empty gun" that sweeps someone and discharges.

* I understand that current Wisconsin law does not require rifles to be cased when transported but range rules should be more stringent than current law.
11. Hands off firearms when down range checking targets.
12. Eye/ear protection at all times on the firing line.
Muzzle's pointed down range at all times, even when uncasing/casing firearms.

Actions open, firearms benched when reposting targets.
Pick up all brass/shells before leaving.

13. There should be no rules more restrictive than what can be done on the rest of DNR lands.
