
BRRTS on the Web (BOTW)

BRRTS on the Web is an online database of more than 60,000 contaminated properties and activities across the state (BRRTS stands for Bureau for Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System).

Use BOTW for information about properties with:

- contamination;
- cleanups, completed or ongoing;
- a DNR determination that no cleanup action is required; and
- emergency spills.

RR Sites Map



RR Sites Map is a web-based mapping system that allows customers to view different layers of contamination data using a Geographic Information System (GIS) tool.

Use RR Sites Map to locate information (including specific documents) about cleanups that are:

- ongoing;
- complete; and
- complete with residual contamination and continuing obligations (land use controls).
