

# 2016 FREE Turkey Hunter Education Clinics!



You are invited to attend one of the following FREE Turkey Hunter Education Clinics to be offered this spring. These clinics provide the perfect opportunity to brush up on your skills or learn new techniques to help you hunt the elusive wild turkey. Clinics typically last 2½ to 3 hours and are designed to cover turkey biology and behavior, hunting methods, regulations, safety precautions, and landowner/hunter ethics. You can look forward to in-depth information on hunting techniques, scoring trophy birds, and a few ideas on preparing your turkey once you get it home. Advance registration is not required.
