

ARE YOU A VETERAN?

LOOKING TO BECOME A CERTIFIED OPERATOR, OR ADD A SUBCLASS TO YOUR CURRENT CERTIFICATION?

You may be eligible for the Veterans Professional Occupational Licensure Fee Waiver Program.

Effective July 1, 2012, veterans may qualify for a **one-time fee waiver** for an occupational or professional license. Veterans may use this waiver **towards the cost of up to 2 operator certification exams**, applied for at the same time, in order to obtain their initial operator certification license in wastewater, municipal waterworks, small water systems, septage, or landfill. In addition, current operators may use the voucher towards the cost of up to 2 exams to add a new subclass to their current certification. Note these vouchers may not be used to pay the cost of renewal fees, or to take advanced exams on existing subclasses.

Veterans must apply for the fee waiver through the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA). The DVA will provide the applicant with an eligibility code that will need to be submitted with the exam application by the postmark deadline.
