

Notice of Informational Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is holding an informational meeting on the final Particulate Matter (PM) National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS).

On February 7, 2024, EPA finalized a more stringent NAAQS for fine particles (PM_{2.5}). The previous PM_{2.5} annual standard set in 2012 was 12 µg/m³. The new, more stringent standard is now 9 µg/m³. The PM_{2.5} 24-hour standard and the PM₁₀ standard will remain unchanged. The DNR Air Management program will host an informational session on March 4, 2024 at 2:30 p.m. to provide an overview of the rule and how it impacts Wisconsin.
