Harvest Requirements

Clear Cut Area Unit 1: (C429-S106)

- Harvest all trees greater than 2" except for Oaks, White Pine, and Black Cherry.

Clear Cut Areas Unit 2: (C429-S5, 6, 11, 37)

- Harvest all White Spruce and Balsam Fir containing 1 or more pulpsticks. In addition, harvest all other Trees greater than 2" except for Oaks, Pines, Cedar Hemlock, Yellow Birch, Tamarack, Black Spruce and Trees marked with **Orange Paint**.

Clear Cut Areas Unit 3: (C429-S9, 24, 39)

- Harvest all White Spruce, Black Spruce and Balsam Fir Containing 1 or more pulpsticks. In addition, harvest all other trees greater than 2" except for Oaks, Pines, Cedar, Hemlock, Yellow Birch, Tamarack and trees marked with **Orange Paint**.

Shelterwood Areas: (C429-S3, 111)

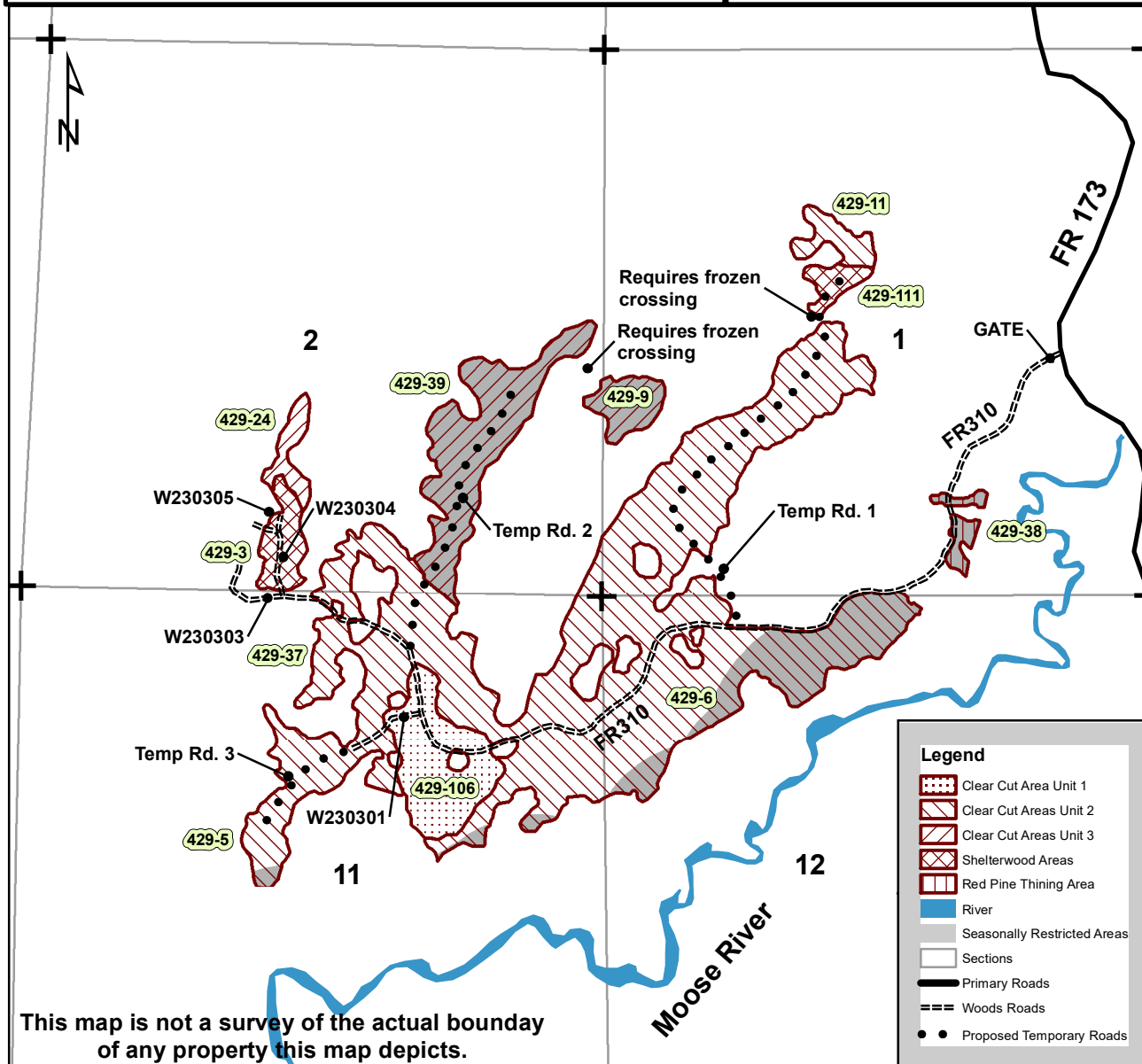
- Harvest all trees greater than 2" except for Oaks, Aspen, Pines, Hemlock, Cedar, and trees marked With **Orange Paint**.

Red Pine Thinning Area: (C429-S38)

- Harvest all trees marked in **Blue Paint**.

General Sale Conditions:

- Sale is bounded with **Orange Paint**.
- Seasonally Restricted Area: Harvest operations are restricted from April 1 through October 1.
- Utilization will be to a 4" top.
- Leave uncut all standing snag and den trees that do not pose a safety hazard.
- Maintain 10ft. wide slash-free zones along FR310.
- Road ID's W230301, W230303, W230304, W230305, Unclassified and Temporary Roads will be decommissioned and closed with an earthen/debris berm following harvest by purchaser.
- All slash shall be lopped and scattered so it lies within 2ft of the ground and kept out of wetlands.
- Provide for an average of 1 ruffed grouse drumming log for every 10 acres of aspen in Clear Cut Units 2 & 3. The log should be 10 or more inches in diameter and at least 12 feet long.

- Mixed Hardwood Pulpwood volume is estimated 35% White Birch, 55% Red Maple, and 10% Other.
- Mixed Hardwood Sawtimber volume is estimated 75% White Birch, 20% Red Maple, and 5% Other.
- Red Pine mixed product is estimated to contain 10MBF and 25 cords of pulpwood.
- Aspen conversion rate is 2.25tons/cord.
- Mix Hardwood conversion rate is 2.40tons/cord.
- Balsam Fir conversion rate is 2.125tons/cord.
- Spruce conversion rate is 2.00tons/cord.
- White Birch conversion rate is 2.40tons/cord.
- Red Maple conversion rate is 2.275tons/cord.
- Red Pine conversion rate is 2.25tons/cord.

Minimum Bid Value: \$161,901.00

Harvest Requirements:

Clear Cut Area Unit 1 (24 acres) – Harvest all trees greater than 2” except for Oaks, White Pine, and Black Cherry.

Clear Cut Areas Unit 2 (220 acres) – Harvest all White Spruce and Balsam Fir containing 1 or more pulpsticks. In addition, harvest all other trees greater than 2” except for Oaks, Pines, Cedar, Hemlock, Yellow Birch, Tamarack, Black Spruce and trees marked with Orange Paint.

Clear Cut Areas Unit 3 (43 acres) – Harvest all White Spruce, Black Spruce, and Balsam Fir containing 1 or more pulpsticks. In addition, harvest all other trees greater than 2” except for Oaks, Pines, Cedar, Hemlock, Yellow Birch, Tamarack and trees marked with Orange Paint.

Shelterwood Areas (12 acres) – Harvest all trees greater than 2” except for Oaks, Aspen, Pines, Hemlock, Cedar, and trees marked with Orange Paint.

Red Pine Thinning Area (4 acres) – Harvest all trees marked in Blue Paint.

Sale is bounded by Orange Paint.

Additional Requirements:

- **This Contract Period is Approx. 3 Years.**
- **Contract ending date is December 31st, 2026.**
- **Seasonally Restricted Area:** No harvest within this area from April 1-October 1. For all other areas harvesting operations may occur during dry summer/fall or frozen conditions. Use is allowed during the restricted time for road ID FR310 to access unrestricted portions of this sale.
- No bid bond required, a performance bond of 15% of the total sale bid value will be required.
- Sale will be mill scaled sale and billed using the mill ticket system.
- Utilization will be to a 4 inch top.
- All slash must always be kept clear of travel ways, removed from the area 10 feet from road edges, kept out of wetlands and riparian areas, and lopped/scattered within 2 feet of ground.
- Maintain 10-foot-wide slash-free zones along Road ID's: FR310.
- Road ID's W230301, W230303, W230304, W230305 and Temporary Roads will be decommissioned and closed with an earthen/debris berm following the harvest by the purchaser.
- Reserve all snags that do not pose a safety risk.
- Provide for an average of 1 ruffed grouse drumming log for every 10 acres of aspen in Clear Cut Units 2 & 3. The log should be 10 or more in diameter and at least 12 feet long.
- Equipment must be inspected by sale administrator and clean of dirt and debris before entering sale area.
- Safety signs are required on public trails and roads entering active harvest areas.

Road and Skid Trails:

- All landings and skid trails should be blocked to vehicular access and possibly re-seeded at the conclusion of use if needed.
- Temporary Roads shall have the road base constructed to a width of 12 feet or narrower, and with vegetative clearing of trees and brush not to exceed a width of 25 feet. Exceptions to the 12-foot maximum width of the road base may be granted by the sale administrator. Exceptions would typically be granted for sections of temporary roads where tight turns, curves, and terrain create a need so that trucks and equipment can be operated safely
- All road maintenance and rehabilitation post-harvest is the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained by request.
