NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

If you believe that you have a right to challenge this decision, you should know that Wisconsin statutes establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed.

To request a contested case hearing pursuant to s. 144.403, Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for a contested case hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. Any such petition for hearing shall set forth specifically the issue sought to be reviewed, the interest of the petitioner, the reasons why a hearing is warranted and the relief desired.

For judicial review of a decision pursuant to ss. 227.52 and 227.53, Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file your petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such a petition for judicial review shall name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND DECISION

Findings of Fact

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) finds that:

- 1) Delco Electronics Corporation, 4066 N. Port Washington Road, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, has applied for an air pollution control permit. The authorized representative of the facility is Clyde Fabrizio, Plant Manager.
- 2) Delco Electronics Corporation submitted an air pollution control permit application and additional information describing the air pollution source on January 12, 1994, May 17, 1996 and June 7, 1996.
- 3) Delco Electronics Corporation sought an air permit to obtain DNR certification of emission reductions from the shutdown of circuit board manufacturing.
- 4) DNR has reviewed Delco Electronics Corporation's air permit application.
- 5) Delco Electronics Corporation discontinued operation of all circuit board manufacturing on August 16 of 1993. All emission units included in the emission reduction option have been removed from the site.
- 6) This permit is for a nonattainment area air pollution source.
- 7) DNR has complied with the procedures set forth in s. 144.392, Statutes.
- 8) The air pollution sources meets all of the applicable criteria in s. 144.393, Statutes.
- 9) DNR has complied with the requirements of s. 1.11, Statutes, and Chapter NR 150, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Conclusions of Law

DNR concludes that:

- 1) DNR has authority under s. 144.31(1)(a), Stats., to promulgate rules contained in chs. NR 400-499, Wis. Adm. Code, including but not limited to rules containing emission limits, compliance schedules and compliance determination methods.
- 2) DNR has the authority under ss. 144.31(1)(a), (e), and (f), 144.375 (4) and (5) and 144.394, Stats., and chs. NR 400-499, Wis. Adm. Code, to establish emission limits for sources of air pollution.

- 3) DNR has the authority to issue air pollution control permits and to include conditions in such permits under ss. 144.391, 144.392, 144.393 and 144.394, Stats.
- 4) The emission limits included in this permit are authorized by ss. 144.394, Stats., and chs. NR 400-499, Wis. Adm. Code.
- 5) DNR is required to comply with s. 1.11, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, in conjunction with issuing an air pollution control permit.

Decision

DNR certifies an emission reduction of seven tons of volatile organic compounds (VOC) from the shutdown of Delco Electronics Corporation previously located at 4066 North Port Washington Road, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
