### Updates

Tracking – A small internal group is working out the details of tracking NR718 approvals. The next step is to look at Low-hazard Exemption (LHE) Tracking and would likely coincide with implementation of the master data layer. New forms are being developed to make information uploaded with NR718 approvals consistent.

Clean Soil Document – This document is in the internal review process, currently. A concern about Arsenic levels was raised and discussed. The option of using background threshold values will be put in the document when it goes out for public comment. The issue will be brought back to the group when feedback is received.

Other States – A summary of discussion with the city of Detroit about their Backfill Management protocol was provided.

Soil Management Documents – A summary of pending and existing soil management documents was provided.

### Discussion

RR-999 NR718 Guidance – DNR staff have been working to overhaul the document following public comment. A summary of changes was presented. The new document is drastically different but more accurately reflects what has been learned about how NR718 works. A revised copy of the document will be discussed with the group during the next public comment period.

NR706 – A guidance document is on hold pending the outcome of the revised NR718 guidance document.
