Changes to the UCCS include:

Task 2

Renamed task from "OPERATION & MAINTENANCE REPORTING" to "ANNUAL GROUNDWATER MONITORING REPORTING". Subtask reference codes renamed from OMR05 & OMR10 to AGMR05 & AGMR10.

Task 4

The following subtask was added: WD17, Landfill Environmental Fee (support documentation must be provided). The unit rate will be the 'actual cost' of the environmental fee.

Task 24

The following subtask was added: WD17, Landfill Environmental Fee (support documentation must be provided). The unit rate will be the 'actual cost' of the environmental fee.

Task 30

With prior department approval this task can also be used to review files for "stalled sites". It can only be used once per site and the review must take place in a Commerce or DNR office.

Schedule rate increase

Rate adjustments were based on input and commodity service data provided by consultants, commodity service providers, other state agencies, variance request approval data, and the application of an Implicit Price Deflator (IPD) computed from U.S. gross domestic product data (Source : U.S. Bureau Economic Analysis | www.bea.doc.gov, NIPA Table 1.1.9. .)

Task Activity Rate increases were computed using an IPD of 2.81%

Laboratory effective IPD rate increases ranged from 2.81% to 4.17%

Modifications to Specifications:

Important clarifications have been made to the introduction paragraphs and the following task specifications listed below. Please read these specifications in the UCCS #8 (link above) for these changes:

Tank System Site Assessment (TSSA) Guidelines:

The Department of Commerce tank system site assessment (TSSA) guidelines, as addressed in section Comm 10.580 (3) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, can now be purchased from Document Sales and Distribution for \$22.30, plus the sales tax described below, by requesting either stock number 61D or the Comm TSSA Guidelines. The attached order form can be used, following the instructions below. Delivery may take about 1 week.

The above price does not include sales tax. Wisconsin residents are required to pay 5% state sales tax, unless exempt by law. There will be an additional 0.5% county sales tax and a 0.1% or 0.5% stadium tax, where applicable, unless exempt by law. **All prices are subject to change without notice.** Incorrectly filled out orders are subject to return and delay.
