





LONG LAKE, IRON COUNTY, 2010**

The Department of Natural Resources conducted a fisheries assessment of Long Lake, Iron County, from April 01, 2010 to April 07, 2010.


Long Lake is a drainage lake in the Chippewa River basin. The walleye fishery is supported primarily through stocking. The population estimate for adult walleye is comparable to area lakes with similar characteristics. Largemouth and smallmouth bass are not sampled effectively during the early spring sampling period. Data presented for largemouth and smallmouth bass may not be representative of the population.










Northern Pike

Some of the other species observed during this sampling but not included in this report were bluegill, black crappie, pumpkinseed, yellow perch, rock bass, and white sucker.

We are also conducting a creel (angler harvest) survey on Long Lake this year. Creel clerk Chuck Janov will count and interview anglers and examine their catch through most of the fishing season.

General Fishing Regulations for Long Lake, Iron County, 2010

FISH SPECIES	OPEN SEASON	DAILY LIMIT	MINIMUM LENGTH
Walleye	May 01-March 06	5	15" MINIMUM
Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass	June 19-March 06	5	14" MINIMUM
Muskellunge	May 29-November 30	1	40" MINIMUM
Northern Pike	May 01-March 06	5	NO MINIMUM
