

## Public Notice on a Proposed Charter under Green Tier and Public Hearing

Pursuant to Section 299.83, Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is proposing to issue an environmental results charter under Green Tier to Wisconsin Urban Wood.

Wisconsin Urban Wood is a network of independent businesses and nonprofit organizations recycling urban wood. Wisconsin Urban Wood promotes the social, environmental and economic value of urban wood to communities and owners across Wisconsin. This network drives utilization of urban forest raw materials to create high value products rather than costly landfill disposals.

The goals of the proposed charter are to enrich Wisconsin Urban Wood's relationship with the Department as well as improve urban forest management practices.
