

Parent File FI 1709/Sale File FM 10380 – Langlade County 20.75 Acres


The Department acquired this parcel for \$14,000 in 1984 for the Statewide Spring Ponds project. It is located in the Town of Elcho in Langlade County.

The parcel has approximately 415 feet of shoreline along Knoke Spring. The spring and its outlet creek are high quality, class 1 naturally reproducing trout water. There is public access to this property from the south across 0.25 miles of Langlade County property off of East Loon Lake Lane. There is also public access to this property from the northeast across 0.60 miles of Langlade County property off of CTH U.

This property should be retained due to the high quality nature of Knoke Spring and its potential as a dredge disposal site for dredging/rehabilitation of the pond to improve habitat for trout.

There may be encroachments of unauthorized motorized vehicle use coming onto the property from adjoining landowners.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
