

File FO 1257– Oneida County 39.29 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$2,700 in 1970.

This parcel is located along County Highway D in the Town of Sugar Camp, approximately six miles southwest of the City of Eagle River. It was purchased for the American Legion State Forest for forestry, game and scenic purposes. The parcel contains numerous wetland bogs and has approximately 765 feet of shoreline on an unnamed lake. There are eagle nests in the area and the parcel itself has suitable habitat for more nests.

Since the parcel is passively managed, the Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the property. It does provide the public with hunting, trapping and passive recreational opportunities. There is merchantable timber on the parcel, but there is no timber harvest currently scheduled.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
