


Parent File G 1700/Sale File WM 60439–Jefferson County 20.98 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$540 in 1963. It is a Statewide Extensive Wildlife Habitat parcel and is located in the Town of Farmington in Jefferson County. The parcel is wetland with willow, boxelder and canary grass.

The property has poor habitat and receives low public use. The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat on the parcel. The parcel is accessible to the public through Switzke Road.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board offer this land for sale under the authority granted by s. 23.145 Wis. Stats.
