

## File G 2025- Jefferson County 39.86 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$2,000 in 1966. It is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Concord in Jefferson County. The parcel was part of a three parcel purchase by the Department to retain habitat conservation in a heavily farmed area for wildlife use. The parcel has good quality Oak, which could be set up for a timber sale.

The parcel is accessible to the public through adjoining Department land via CTH P. There is high public use on the parcel in fall for deer hunting.

The Department has made investments on the larger property that include a parking area and property boundary posting work.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
