

## File G 2028- Jefferson County 38.89 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$2,130 in 1966. The parcel is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Koshkonong in Jefferson County.

An unnamed stream runs through the parcel, which flows to the Rock River, providing approximately 1250 feet of two bank frontage. The parcel has a well-known blue heron rookery. Conservation groups have installed approximately a dozen wood duck boxes on the parcel.

The parcel is accessible to the public through an easement off of North Shore Road and HWY 106. The parcel is popular for deer hunting, bird viewing and access to the stream on the parcel, which runs into the Rock River.

There is a current timber sale on the north end of the parcel. The stand includes ash, aspen, swamp white oak and silver maple.

The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the parcel.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
