

## File G 2516– Jefferson County 21.31 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$1,700 in 1969 for trout habitat and high quality pheasant nesting cover. The parcel is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Waterloo in Jefferson County.

Stony Brook flows through the parcel providing approximately 1200 feet of two bank frontage. This protected wetland enhances that water body which flows into the Maunasha and Crawfish Rivers, as well as Mud and Chub Lake.

The parcel can be accessed by the public from an easement off of Airport Road. It is heavily used for hunting and trapping in the fall and winter.

The Department has not made substantial investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the parcel.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board retain this parcel.
