Act 168 says:

The 12 Sporting Heritage Council members shall be appointed for 3 year terms.

The Council shall consist of:

DNR (Scott Gunderson)

Governor's appointee (Bill Torhorst)

2 members of the Senate (Neal Kedzie and Bob Wirch)

2 members of the Assembly (Jim Steineke and Nick Milroy)

1 member representing deer hunters (Ralph Fritsch)

1 member representing bear hunters (Mike Rogers)

1 member representing bird hunters (Mark LaBarbera)

1 member representing anglers (Ben Gruber)

1 member representing furbearers (Scott Zimmerman)

1 member representing the Conservation Congress (Joe Caputo)

It then says:

3 of the members shall be appointed for terms expiring July 1, 2014

(Sen. Kedzie, Sen. Wirch, Rep. Milroy)

3 of the members shall be appointed for terms expiring July 1, 2015

(Rep. Steineke, Ralph Fritsch, Ben Gruber)

2 of the members shall be appointed for terms expiring July 1, 2016

(Joe Caputo, Bill Torhorst)

3 members re-appointed to terms expiring July 1, 2016

(Mike Rogers, Mark LaBarbera, Scott Zimmerman)

Act 168 says the Council shall meet at least one time per year.
