Subject: **New Federal Regulations: Initial Notification Forms Due May 9, 2008**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) recently finalized rules for existing and new Gasoline Dispensing Facilities (GDF).

You are receiving this mailing because we believe you are potentially impacted by this new regulation.

If you are an existing GDF and have a monthly throughput of 10,000 gallons or more, **you must submit the attached Initial Notification/Notification of Compliance Status Report to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and USEPA by May 9, 2008** (or within 15 days of start up for new or reconstructed GDFs).

We have enclosed the federal brochure summarizing these regulations for your review and urge you to read 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart CCCCCC – *National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Area Source Category: Gasoline-Dispensing Facilities* and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart A – *National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories, Subpart A – General Provisions* to determine your facility's specific regulatory requirements.

Depending upon your facility's circumstances, the rule may require additional maintenance, record keeping, and equipment upgrades as well as compliance reporting.
