Project name and primary purpose (after acquisition):

Wolf River Sturgeon Trail Acquisition: The purpose of acquiring these three parcels, 1129 S. Water, 1207 S. River, and 1219 S. River street; is to create a corridor along the Wolf River connecting Sturgeon Park, the Mountain Bay State Trail, public boating facility and Kuckuk Park; greatly increasing recreational access to the waterway.

Parcel size, shape and topography: Describe the size, shape, and topography of the parcel.

Parcel at 1129 S Water is 1.05 acres with 120' frontage on the Wolf River.

Parcel at 1207 S. River Street is .36 acres with 162' frontage on the Wolf River.

Parcel at 1219 S. River Street is .15 acres with 94' frontage on the Wolf River.

All parcels are relatively flat, rectangular shaped.
