



Harvesting Prescription:

Harvest Area: Harvest all trees 2" DBH and larger. **EXCEPT:** swamp white oak, red oak, white pine, elm, hemlock, spruce, balsam fir and green paint marked trees.

Utilize all cut trees that will make one or more 100" pulpwood stick to a 4" top D.I.B. Harvesting will only be permitted between December 1 and February 29, or during periods of frozen ground condition.

Special Considerations:

Any new road location and construction on State land is subject to review and approval by the Department of Natural Resources. Prior to the timber sale closeout procedure, all trails and roads used in the harvesting operation must be free of slash, logging debris, ruts and be level (pre-sale condition). No slash can be left on private land, the snowmobile trail nor the field. Caution must be used when operating adjacent to the snowmobile trail.
