




Tract (18-15) Before the Snow Sale




Select Cut Area (233 acres) - Bounded by red paint line. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1)snags 2)cull trees 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only **marked** aspen. Cut all balsam fir with 2 sticks or more and merchantable ironwood.



Aspen Area (4 acres) - Bounded by yellow paint line. Cut all trees greater than 2 inches **except for:** 1) white pine, 2) oak, 3) cedar, 4) hemlock.



Purple Gap Area (6 acres) - Bounded by purple paint line. Cut all trees greater than 1 inch **except for:** 1)white pine, 2) oak 3) cedar, 4) hemlock, 5) purple "X" marked trees.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or Mixed Saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately **three years**.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions between Dec. 1st-March 31st due to this entire sale being within a special management unit and wet soil conditions.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut area due to density and distribution of regeneration.

A temporary in stream crossing is required to cross the stream located on the map. All permit requirements shall be followed by contractor. The permit has been obtained by the DNR.

Motor vehicle access during hunting season (Sept. 15-Dec. 1) shall be for logging purposes only. (i.e road building)

A special management area may need to be designated with logging restrictions between February 1st and August 1st, prior to harvesting on the sale.

The hunter/walker trail may be used for multiple sales. It is the responsibility of the contractors of those sales to determine the logistics for hauling.

The drainage crossing may need timber mats to cross if adequate snow is not available for fill.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
